

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I. PROGRAM OVERVIEW

PROBLEM

Our Constitutional Republic is dying. Few citizens now have the knowledge, appreciation, and passion to champion the founding values, principles and institutions—all found in the Declaration of Independence and Constitution—that made this nation the greatest on earth. This national decline is a disastrous betrayal by the current generation of future generations and must immediately be reversed if America is to be saved.

OPPORTUNITY

America's 20 million veterans are among our nation's most trusted and respected citizens. Many qualities make them uniquely qualified to reverse our national decline, including their lifelong oath to the Constitution, training to achieve any given mission, and proven dedication to defending our nation. After separating from the military, many struggle in civilian life. They represent a huge, untapped resource who would eagerly embrace once more having a mission and chain of command to achieve a greater purpose as "Champions of Liberty."

SOLUTION

Our nation must tap the enormous resource of America's veterans by training and tasking them to restore the knowledge and love of our unique national heritage, principles and institutions among the people, especially youth, civic leaders, government officials and political candidates.

PROGRAM

Veterans in Defense of Liberty[®] (ViDoL) is pleased to announce the launch of our "Champions of Liberty" veteran-driven, nationwide educational outreach program for the summer of 2019. ViDoL reached this milestone by bringing together three co-sponsors, creating a collaboration of four nationally renowned organizations that each provide an essential part of the whole program:

1. Recruitment & Program Management: Veterans in Defense of Liberty®, the leader and developer of this program, is a nationwide non-profit 501(c)(4) advocacy corporation based in Springfield, Missouri, comprised of military veterans and their close associates organized into eight Divisions, divided into 50 Regiments (states) and 435 Battalions (Congressional Districts). Every veteran participant will be directed by ViDoL to connect with or start a ViDoL Battalion for local outreach—a "force multiplier" to spread this knowledge rapidly into their communities. ViDoLis ideally structured to reach out to America's veterans who are ready and eager to become part of this historic mission to save our nation by restoring its founding principles.












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- **2. Lecture and Classroom Facilities:** The National Archives in Washington, D.C's mission is to "strengthen democracy by allowing Americans to claim their rights of citizenship, hold their government accountable, and understand their history so they can participate more effectively in their government." Its prime location near Capitol Hill provides a crucial beachhead for advancing America's founding principles by "encouraging creativity and investing in innovation to build our future." Those bedrock principles of our great national prosperity and security include free enterprise, limited government, individual freedom, traditional American values, and a strong national defense. The National Archives McGowan Theater provides the ideal venue for launching Champions of Liberty's historic program training veterans in preserving these blessings of liberty for generations to come.
- **3. Training, Public Speaking and Media:** Leadership Institute, Arlington, Virginia. Since 1979, Morton Blackwell's Leadership Institute has trained nearly 200,000 conservative activists, from college students to seasoned politicians, in public speaking, debate, live interviews, broadcast media, and more. With its professional-level TV studio facilities, they provide critical training veterans will need to continue serving their country in this new invisible Battlefield of Ideas. Their nationwide campus network also opens the door to a huge young audience to hear what our Champions of Liberty have to say.
- **4. Training, Veteran-Led Media and Heritage:** The American Veterans Center (AVC) in Arlington, Virginia, under the leadership of President James Roberts produces film, television, radio (AVC Radio and Radio America) and publications by veterans, for veterans and all Americans. Their annual American Veterans Conference welcomes hundreds of graduating cadets who learn our nation's great heritage directly from the hero history makers. AVC's professional radio and video studios annually produce the Emmy-winning, national broadcast, "American Valor: A Salute to our Heroes." They have recorded thousands of oral histories from living veterans of all conflicts since WWII, and also host the nation's largest Memorial Day parade in Washington, D.C. AVC will supplement Leadership Institute with hands on experience in TV and radio interviewing. Each veteran will be afforded the opportunity to video record their, oral history for posterity. Radio America provides the opportunity to establish a weekly, champions of liberty radio program.





II. EXPANDED PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Veterans in Defense of Liberty® (ViDoL) is pleased to announce the launch of our "Champions of Liberty" veteran-driven nationwide educational outreach program in the summer of 2019. As a nationwide non-profit 501(c)(4) corporation based in Springfield, Missouri, ViDoL is well-structured to achieve this mission. ViDol is comprised of eight Divisions, divided into 50 Regiments (states) and 435 Battalions (Congressional Districts). Equally important to the success of our mission is the respect that Americans in general have for the military.

The American military veteran holds a special distinction of trust among fellow citizens, for whom they risked all to defend. Their oath to support and defend our Constitution—a mission they remain dedicated for life to achieving—qualifies them to serve as much-needed patriotic role models for all Americans. Veterans are a huge, silent, untapped force for liberty with the potential to accomplish any mission if properly trained, equipped and organized within a chain of command to which they are accustomed.

Pew Research Center has confirmed (see appendix) the military is among the most trusted of all American institutions (79%), and especially likely to contribute to our society's wellbeing (92%). Pew concludes: "On balance, the military is viewed positively by all major social and demographic groups. Men and women are about equally likely to see the military as contributing a lot to society. And there are no significant differences in views on the military's contribution to society among adults younger and older than age 50 or among those with differing levels of formal schooling."

National respect for our military extends to her veterans. In 2018 the Roper Center reported a strong parallel between the military and the veteran. An MTV/AP-NORC Youth Political Pulse Survey reported a full 80% of millennial Americans were excited to vote for a candidate who was a military veteran.

To that end, ViDoL will provide the national platform for honorably discharged military veterans to serve as Champions of Liberty within their communities. ViDoL will facilitate this training of veterans in the principles of American history, liberty, the Declaration of Independence and Constitution, our republican form of limited government, advocacy for these principles, public speaking, and much more.

The Mission of this new nationwide educational outreach program is to electrify that vast network of veterans, to train, equip, and organize them, so that together we can work to restore the true tenets of American liberty as secured for us by our Founding Fathers.

The urgent need for this program cannot be overstated. Decades of educational neglect has left our youth without knowledge of American civics, leaving them unequipped to defend our great nation. They are unable to oppose systemic corruption by cultural, media and educational institutions which present failed ideologies like socialism and communism as equally valid government models to our superior Western ideals of individual liberty, economic freedom and the rule of law embodied in our Declaration of Independence and Constitution. We must also revive the American Melting Pot for the waves of immigrants pouring across our borders. They bring with them the same set of failed ideologies that they flee, yet cling to, as they meet only silence from our

official institutions. As we teach them about our national melting pot, the chef will be the American Veteran, the Declaration and Constitution his "cookbooks," and the first ingredient is Liberty. His recipe notes include our own glorious history and the Founder's ancillary writings like the Federalist Papers, as well as the works of the giants on whose shoulders they stood, from Montesquieu to the ancient Greek and Roman philosophers, to the Bible.

If our veterans remain silent, untrained, and unorganized our Constitutional Republic is at grave risk of being swamped by a cacophony of worthless ideas that have proven fatal to freedom and to civilizations. Today, conservative founding principles are attacked by entities from within and without our borders existing using virtually all nation-shaping institutions including the news media, academia, philanthropic organizations, entertainment, sports, social media, and the United Nations.

Reversing this suicidal cultural trend requires rapid education, training, equipping, and deploying that vast network of dedicated, credible, respected veterans to inculcate the timeless truths of our founding back into the American psyche. Only then will we be able to resurrect and restore our Republic.

Veterans are America's reserve force of Champions of Liberty. They recognize it as their solemn duty to stand sentinel - actively engaged in the battlefield of ideas - to safeguard our rights and assure Freedom and Liberty triumph in perpetuity. This can be guaranteed only by the sworn defenders of the Constitution declaring: "Return the reins of government power into the hands of 'We the People!"

As an ancillary benefit, giving a new, powerful purpose to men and women who put their lives on the line to defend our Republic will help inoculate them from afflictions that affect so many of our bravest upon leaving the service: depression, addiction, and suicide. With renewed purpose come focus, knowing their most important work in life still lies ahead.

There is no other organization positioned to muster the number of mission-driven patriots, still under oath to "serve and protect the Constitution," to accomplish this historic mission. ViDoL is the only organization with the charter to equip America's vast number of veterans—our "boots on the ground"—with the dedication and courage to counter the dangerous ideas being propagated against our nation and its leading patriots, and restore the right thinking that made this nation the greatest, strongest, freest nation on earth. All that our veterans require to accomplish that mission is the specific knowledge and training to weaponize the truth in order to win on that ever present yet largely invisible Battlefield of Ideas.

Developed in co-sponsorship with the top conservative media-training institute, Morton Blackwell's Leadership Institute in Arlington, Virginia, plus a leading conservative Midwestern College, and The American Veteran Center in Washington D.C., the first course will be "Why We Fought." This course will enable American veterans across the country to take a leadership role in restoring and defending the founding moral and





















governing principles of our Constitutional Republic. Topics covered in the 5-day program include America's Founding Principles, History and Heritage, the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, Leadership Principles and Style, Public Speaking, Debate, Television and Radio Training, and How to Be an Effective Advocate for Conservative American Values.

Initial training will be augmented by mission-focused tours of Washington, D.C. and environs, as well as internet courses, expert videos on current issues, an Operation manual, pamphlets, flyers, ready access to current information, expert advice and guidance. Amplifying this will be the fact that each veteran is once again engaged in mission accomplishment with his brothers and sisters in whom each has unbounded trust. As a group they will support, challenge and train one another.

Veterans completing the course will possess a solid understanding and ability to defend the foundations of our Republic. These Champions of Liberty will be prepared to operate in all areas of our diverse communities, better able to articulate why the greatest treasure bequeathed to posterity by our Founding Fathers was the Idea of Liberty articulated in our Declaration of Independence, anchored in our Judeo-Christian moral principles, and protected by our Constitution, which binds and limits our government by the consent of the governed. They will be prepared to share this knowledge, respect and love for the principles of American Liberty at every level of their local communities, schools, churches, civic organizations, colleges & universities.

These Champions of Liberty will also be alert sentinels ready to move at a moment's notice to squash the propagation of radical ideas presented by those in the news media, social media, academia and politics who either without understanding or through purposeful hostility attack our values. The Champions of Liberty will be the white blood cells in the bloodstream of our Republic, fighting infection wherever it might arise.

The training for the initial course is especially beneficial for veterans who wish to become leaders in returning Constitutional Fidelity within their community; as well as teachers/professors, those in media, community leadership, and other nation-shaping roles. All American veterans whose DNA is anchored firmly in the precious ideals of liberty and character traits rather than superficiality are encouraged to avail themselves of this opportunity – to save our nation!

As one combat veteran declared, "Finally I'll have a legacy and purpose!" Another said, "Wow, little did I know that the entirety of my overseas combat military service was just a boot camp in the eternal struggle for freedom." Our response: "Welcome to the real fight, son!"

Touring Our Nation's Capital City – Immersion in Our Glorious American Heritage

A Luncheon program will be seated in the United States Capitol, after which veterans will be afforded the time to visit with their Representatives and Senators. Each participant will be expected to schedule these meetings before arriving in D.C. They will also participate in insider tours of The National Archives and Library of Congress and other buildings and institutions.

These "hands-on days" where our veterans will begin their transformation to Constitutional Activists. Conservative constitutional activists who are learning how to win!

A closer look at several training courses and experiences

Activist Training and Public Relations Workshop

Students will learn how to: be an activist; develop a strategic plan; Set expectations; Hold elected officials accountable; network for success.

They will learn how to translate their message into a media strategy for positive coverage by, developing the right message for their target audience; using social media to spread that message; building valuable relationships with the media; communicating effectively through writing, speaking, and interpersonal skills.

Public Speaking Workshop

Participants will learn effective public speaking techniques and will be coached through a speech sample while receiving personalized critiques.

They will learn to: professionally and effectively prepare and deliver a speech; Overcome common fears about speaking in public, Understand strategies for effective communication with audience members; the importance of non-verbals like appropriate dress, gestures, and appearance.

Debate Workshop

Receive the essential skills for developing a winning argument at your next debate.

Analyze successful and unsuccessful debate techniques using real-life examples.

Learn to, effectively communicate your platform to your audience through strategy and preparation, develop an opening statement, ask and answer questions, handle the unexpected and stand your "rhetorical ground"

How to Write Effective Commentary Workshop

Training to, "write on what you care about and how to write in such a way that other people will care about it too."

This powerful course will teach how to: Create structured arguments; Craft meaningful points; Develop gripping headlines that hook; Research and weave research into your piece; Make your points and finish strong.

Speech Writing Workshop

Develop speeches that withstand press scrutiny. Learn the primary components of speech writing, including research, argument development, formatting.

Understand target audiences; pro-active messaging; winning strategies; and effective impact; deliver speeches professionally; organize and prepare effective speeches; think on your feet in impromptu speeches.

Camera Workshop

This workshop will be held in Leadership Institutes Norma Zimdahl Master Studio in the Sacher Multimedia Center. The participant will develop their on-camera message and delivery techniques; Learn best practices for on-camera gestures and facial expressions; They will gain confidence in their on-camera ability.

Mock on television interviews will be tied by, topic and talking points, to the information learned during their first three days.

American Veterans Center, "Veterans Oral History"

Veteran participants will have the opportunity to contribute to the "Veteran Oral History" program produced by the American Veterans Center (AVC) in their Radio America Studios.

Contributors will record, in front of the camera, their memories of military service. Thereby, they will materially contribute to AVC 's historical program to guard the legacy and honor the sacrifice of all who have served. Their memory video will be filed in perpetuity in the Congressional Library.





















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Dinner and Banquet Program

Included in the week's experience will be two dinner programs which will enhance the educational experience, as well as advance the bonding process of the group - a dinner program the first night and a graduation banquet the last night; attire for both will be business. A social hour will precede both dinners; if drinks are available, they will be on a cash basis.

Both dinner and the banquet will feature a nationally recognized expert in their field. In addition to providing further Constitutionally conservative knowledge, these renowned speakers will ingrain our Champions of Liberty with an understanding of the vital role they play in restoring our Republic. The trust and respect shown by nationally respected speakers will positively impact the confidence of these cultural warriors, further empowering them to accomplish their mission.

Part of the benefit of supporting a student in the Champions of Liberty academic setting is seeing the result of installing informed and trained patriots back into their individual communities, all over the United States. The methodology described below is what we call our "Force Multiplier," whereby the impact of Champions of Liberty is felt on the home front at an exponentially enhanced rate. Consider the following:


Each student who successfully completes the week-long, intensive training session in Washington D.C., will be bestowed with an initial designation of a Champion of Liberty, which will soon be recognized as a degree of recognition known for its capacity to change the debate anywhere, ideologically and intellectually.

However, in order to maintain that designation, the alumni will be required to engage in the battle for our liberty in whatever geographical location they find themselves - due to work, higher education attendance, (local, State or Federal campaign) or home. This engagement would entail an annual minimum of:

- 200 hours of Community education (less than 4 hours a week), whether by mass media (radio, social networking, etc.), or by holding classes available to the public on various issues facing the Republic on a daily basis (Local Libraries, volunteering in Community Centers, etc.), which will, conservatively estimated, bring the message of Constitutional Fidelity as the means to save our nation from its current degradation to approximately Twenty Million people across the country, at a rate of more than 8,000 collective hours per year. Given that there are only 8,760 hours in an entire year, this means that, on average, **every nine minutes that passes**, someone, somewhere in the United States, will be teaching the higher principles of Liberty to a culture starving to hear it, every hour, of every day, every day of the year!
- Teach the basic course core principles of the Champions of Liberty curriculum to six veterans within their home field arena (Battalion), each of whom, upon successful completion of the short course, would be eligible for the designation of "Defender of Liberty," enabling these individuals to be led into the larger program with a "leg up" on the course work, should they choose to advance to the next level. However, as individuals taught these principles to a high degree of understanding, these Defenders of Liberty would also be required to offer 50 hours of Community education annually, in the same formats outlined above, which would increase the number of hours of local teaching of Liberty principles by an additional 12,000 hours, each year, totaling 20,000 hours, reaching 20 Million people per year, and that is all just from the very first class of the Champions of Liberty program!

% of U.S. adults who say they have _____ of confidence in each of the following groups to act in the best interests of the public





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Perceptions of Occupational Groups


% saying each group contributes to society's well-being ...
